## OCT MAINSTAGE

A \$5 fee per ticket applies if you exchange with less than 24 hours' notice.

**Can I get a refund?** OCT has a no refunds policy for all ticket purchases. All sales are final. If a performance is canceled, the box office will contact you with ticket options.
