OCT MAINSTAGE

Shows run for three weeks. Performances are Thursdays* at 7:30 p.m., Fridays at 7:30 p.m., Saturdays at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m., and Sundays at 2 p.m.

*The Velocity of Autumn does not have a performance on Thanksgiving (Nov. 23).

OCT RATTLEBOX AT THE REILLY

Beginning this season, we also are partnering with the local arts community to bring OCT to the heart of Ocala! At the Reilly Arts Center, in the intimate space of the NOMA Black Box, OCT will present our Rattlebox at the Reilly series: Witch and Stage Kiss. Shows run for two weeks. Performances are Thursdays at 7:30 p.m., Fridays at 7:30 p.m., Saturdays at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m., and Sundays at 2 p.m. Tickets are general seating.

OCT Education & Enrichment's Summerstage youth production of Peter Pan Jr. is a magical way to start Season 73! The show runs one weekend, July 28-30, with three performances: Friday at 7:30 p.m., Saturday at 2 p.m., and Sunday at 2 p.m. Subscribers can purchase tickets in advance at a discount.

Groups of 10 or more can purchase tickets as early as one month before a show goes on sale to the general public.

- → 21-30 tickets: \$4 off per ticket for evenings and \$2 off per ticket for matinees
- → 31-40 tickets: \$4 off per ticket for evenings and \$2 off per ticket for matinees, PLUS one free ticket
- ♦ 41 or more tickets: \$4 off per ticket for evenings and \$2 off per ticket for matinees, PLUS two free tickets

What's a Standing Reservation? A Standing Reservation gives you a regular performance day and the same seats for each show. When you fill out the order form in this brochure, you can state your preferred day and seating area. Every effort will be made to place you in the section you request. Priority in seat assignment for OCT Mainstage shows is based on length of subscription and donor history. Please send in your order forms and payment as soon as possible, since priority for new subscribers is determined by the date your order was received and your donor category. Reservation and ticketing procedures are subject to change.

What's a Flex Pass? With a Flex Pass, you decide which shows you want to see and which performance of each show you want to attend. Then, beginning August 7, you can call or stop by the box office to make reservations for each show in your subscription.

TICKET POLICIES

How do I purchase tickets? To purchase single tickets, please call the box office at (352) 236-2274 or stop by Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. You also may purchase tickets online any time at ocalacivictheatre.com. To purchase season tickets, please fill out the order form in this brochure and return or mail it to the theatre.

How do I get my tickets? Physical tickets will not be printed. You will receive an e-mail confirmation. When you come to a performance, we will check you in by name.

Can I exchange my tickets for another date? We are happy to exchange your tickets for another performance of the same show with at least 24 hours' notice before your scheduled performance, based on availability. Please contact the box office during our regular business hours, or e-mail your request to exchange@ocalacivictheatre.com. A \$5 fee per ticket applies if you exchange with less than 24 hours' notice.

Can I get a refund? OCT has a no refunds policy for all ticket purchases. All sales are final. If a performance is canceled, the box office will contact you with ticket options.

Reservation and ticketing procedures are subject to change.






SEPTEMBER 7-24, 2023




